
Business Services Team

Small Business Equity & Recovery



EDB was awarded a \$300,000 grant from the American Rescue Plan Act Small Business Equity & Recovery (APRA) to further expand the work of our existing Business Diversity Program.

Program work includes recovery efforts for Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) owned-businesses that were disproportionately impacted by the pandemic. A programmatic review is currently underway as part of the scope of work of this grant and will be presented to the Board of Supervisors in 2024.

Access Sonoma Broadband



Access Sonoma Broadband is an ongoing initiative at EDB to work with communities to close the digital divide through infrastructure design and deployment, access, affordability, and implementing digital equity in Sonoma County.



BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT

- Completed high level broadband design for Sonoma County using Local Agency Technical Assistance grant.
- Applied for \$17.2 million from Federal Funding Account for last mile infrastructure projects at four priority areas.



BROADBAND ACCESS

- Enrolled 4,151 households in the Affordable Connectivity Program.
- Hosted the Broadband Equity Access and Deployment Regional Planning Workshop with 200+ stakeholders and community members in attendance.

Sonoma Mendocino Economic Development District

Sonoma Mendocino Economic Development District (SMEDD) is a **two-county partnership** that engages in regional economic development planning. SMEDD oversees the implementation of the region's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS).


